Not only has the literate allowed users to work, from home and to shop from home, but it also has allowed users to socialize without ever leaving the house. One of the beauties of online socializing is its convenience. Simply by running a search on the computer, a person can produce a list of lundreds of people with whom to chat, all with the qualities requested.
