### **Case I:** Discharge summary- Transurethral resection of the prostate

Pt: male, age 92

Dx: Benign prostatic hyperplasia with retention and hydronephrosis

Mr. John Smith was brought to the hospital for a TUR for reasons itemized in the H&P. He underwent a TUR of the trilobar gland on 9/21. On 9/22 cystoclysis was clear. He had one degree of temperature and went to straight drainage. On 9/23 his temperature was normal, with slight hematuria. The catheter was removed. On 9/24 he was afebrile, urine: light diluted cherry kool-aid color. A postoperative instruction sheet was given to Mr. Smith. He read it and had no questions. He was given a prescription for Achromycin 250mg qid and discharged. Pathology report: 40gms of benign tissue with mild focal, acute, and chronic prostatitis.

Pt: female, age 10

Dx: 1. status asthmaticus      2. probable viral syndrome

Ellen Black is a ten-year-old girl with no known previous history of asthma, although she does have a history bronchitis during which she has had episodes of wheezing. Ellen has had respiratory symptoms and fever since Monday morning and now has increasing respiratory distress on the day of admission. She was seen in the office of Dr. Laytham who reported tightness in the chest. Pulse oximetry revealed and O2 saturation of 81%. Ellen was therefore sent to the hospital, treated overnight with oxygen, intravenous Aminophylline and Bronkosol, as well as IV Zinacef. She appears to be more comfortable at this point with less tachypnea and better oxygen saturation.
